Willow Tree Housing Partnership Limited (WTHP) is committed to raising awareness of domestic abuse and providing a victim centred, confidential and caring response, to any reports of domestic abuse. We will always consider reports of domestic abuse as serious incidents and treat them as such. If you are suffering from domestic abuse please give us a call on 01934 750780.

We treat all reports in confidence and will take no action without your permission. The only exception to this is where there is the abuse of children or we perceive an immediate threat to your personal safety; in which case we have a duty of care to pass on information to Social Services.

How Will We Help?

With your permission, we will refer you to one of the dedicated organisations who are the experts in assisting people suffering from domestic abuse. As part of that process we may ask to complete a DASH form to assess your situation and see how we can best help you, or who to refer you to.

We have a domestic abuse champion who oversees the process, offering support to both you, and our colleagues, when helping you through an understandably difficult time.
